MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

I. OPENING ITEMS

- A. Call to Order** – President Charlie Schneider called the meeting of the Board of Education of the School District of the Menomonie Area to order at 5:57 p.m. on Monday, April 25, 2022, in the boardroom of the Administrative Service Center at 215 Pine Avenue E., Menomonie, Wisconsin.
- B. Roll Call and Quorum** – Roll call showed nine board members present: Rachel Henderson, Mark Hillman, Tanya Husby, Karl Palmer, Amy Riddle-Swanson, Charlie Schneider, Angie Skillings, Abe Smith, and Dominique Stewart. President Schneider declared a quorum and noted that the meeting had been duly noticed. III. ACTION AGENDA


- A. Approve Extension of SDMA Longevity Incentives** – Henderson made a motion, seconded by Palmer, that the board approves the extension of SDMA Longevity Incentives. Motion passed 9-0 by electronic vote.

IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS/POLICY REVIEW

- A. Review Annual School Nutrition Report** - Director of School Nutrition Services Michelle Kloser reported to the board department highlights. The district participated in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) which took place of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program

(SBP), Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, Child and Adult Care Food Program, After School Snack Program, Special Milk Program, and Summer Food Service Program. District participation in the lunch program has increased 5% from September, and participation in the breakfast program has increased 13%. Currently waivers are not extended to the next school year and will end the last day of school, June 2, 2022. Families not qualifying for free meals will have to pay for lunch in the 2022-2023 school year.

- B. Review 2021-2022 Professional Development Needs Assessment Survey Report** – Once every three years the SDMA conducts a Professional Development Needs Assessment Survey as one of the ways the district gathers input from staff to help inform the professional development planning process. The board reviewed and discussed staff responses from the survey.
 - C. Review 2021-2022 Budget Revisions** – Director of Business Services Leah Theder reported to the board 2021-2022 budget revisions. The revisions will be brought back for Board approval on May 9, 2022.
 - D. Review Strategic Planning Goals and Major Activities for 2021-2022** –The board reviewed and discussed progress on the SDMA Strategic Planning Goals and Major Activities for 2021-2022. Information about the district's strategic planning work can be found on the school district website.
